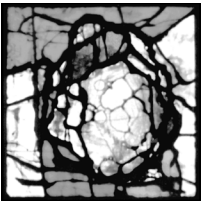

Blast from the Past(or) Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity June 11, 2017

The Easter season concluded with a bang last week, replete with tongues of fire and mighty wind. The event that is the Holy Spirit now forces us to contemplate the most intricate and fundamental revelation of Christianity: The Holy Trinity. One God, three Persons. Got that? Easy-peasy. Thankfully, many gifted minds have helped folks like me by shedding light on this Mystery. In *Mere Christianity*, the great CS Lewis wrote, 'an ordinary, simple Christian kneels down to say his prayers. He is trying to get into touch with God. But if he is a Christian, he knows that what is prompting him to pray is also God: God, so to speak, inside him. But he also knows that all his real knowledge of God comes through Christ, Who is standing beside him, helping him to pray, praying for him. You see what is happening? God is the goal he is trying to reach. God is also inside him, pushing him on. God is also the road...along which he is being pushed to that goal. So that the threefold life of the three-personal God is actually going on in that ordinary little bedroom where an ordinary man is saying his prayers.' Got that? Simple, profound and mind-boggling. There you have it. God's innermost secret is that He is an **eternal exchange of love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit and He has destined us to share in that exchange** (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 221). Christianity is about beauty, folks, and it is this Beauty that will save the world. May the Trinitarian pattern of life permeate your hearts and homes.
